3. Our main goal(s) as a partnership this year is / are to:

Working on a more unified approach across Swale with similar offer of support which helps with parental engagement and understanding. Improved transition and continuity of experience from primary to secondary to avoid conflict and support engagement. We would also like to work on supporting young people whose EHCP primary need is related to behaviour and/or SEMH.

4. We specifically want to get better as a partnership at:

Supporting teachers with children whose needs are outlined as SEMH/behaviour
Supporting transition for parents between phase and schools
Offering positive strategies that can be used across the partnership.
Getting better at sharing our previous experiences and supporting each with similar issues.

5. Our main concern(s) at the moment are:

Increased deprivation and needs of families and the link between this and the higher number of EHCPs in these families. We are also concerned that there is a very high number of EHCs in Swale (in part due to expertise of school's identifying needs due to experience). The higher than average number of looked after children and requests for places for these demonstrates we have excellent history of supporting children but increases the requests for places for these children.

6. We have confidence in our collective ability to:

Work together collegiately, our individual staff expertise, cross phase of selective and primary. Despite working in a challenging area we have had significant successes with young people who would previous not have lasted in mainstream.
